

EQUALITY ANALYSIS

Set out below is the equality analysis relating to those projects, where time limited funding has either ended or is being reduced.

Budget Line	Equality Analysis
GLLP	It is intended that this service carries on, albeit on a reduced basis. There is no equalities impact of this proposal on either service delivery or employees.
e-Business Support	This service provides digital inclusion support to the business community. There is no equalities impact of this proposal on either service delivery or employees.
Anti Poverty Contingency	This service includes provision of additional DHP payments and support for UC claimants. The council receives funding from the government for DHP and it is the additional element of local funding that will cease in 2019/20. Proposals will be brought forward to maximise the effective use of those resources going forward. Further, the council intends to provide funding for the continuation of support to UC claimants. The council considers that the withdrawal of this additional level of funding (for DHP) will have a low overall impact on protected groups.
Emergency Support Scheme	The experience of the service is that there is no particular protected group which uses this service and therefore the council considers that the withdrawal of this funding will have a low overall impact on protected groups.
Violent and Organised Crime Unit & Domestic Violence	This provided additional funding for these areas. The MPS continues to target violent and organised crime, alongside DV perpetrators. The council considers that the withdrawal of this additional level of funding will have a low overall impact on protected groups.
Adult Community Learning	The council continues to provide adult community learning and considers that the withdrawal of this additional level of funding will have a low overall impact on protected groups.
