The petition read as follows:	<p>We hereby petition the Royal Borough of Greenwich to remove the enforcement camera recently placed at the junction of Wricklemarsh Road SE3 0NE with Rochester Way and undertake a review of the no-left-turn restriction at that point.</p> <p>The introduction of automatic and expensive fines for breaches which are often accidental and without any impact on road safety or the flow of traffic is excessive and exploitative. All the more so when turning right provides no point of egress. We also urge the Council to consider that the original grounds for the 'no left turn' (restricting access to the A2M) are now redundant when an enforcement camera placed at the slipway itself can apply the necessary control without having to swathe surrounding streets in blanket restrictions</p>

I. **Petition Response**

I.1 Highway Committee to note the receipt of the petition and endorse officers' recommendations to: explore the option to implement a no entry onto the A102 and relocate the enforcement camera to enforce this new restriction, this will include the removal of the banned turns on Wricklemarsh Road and Westbrook Road.

I.2 The available options are:

- i. Proceed with the actions as outlined in paragraph 1.1 and consider this for a future work programme
- ii. Keep the banned turn and remove the enforcement camera

2 Current actions being taken in relation to matter raised in petition

- 2.1 Option 1 is the preferred option for Royal Greenwich. The next steps to implement this would be to prepare a design for the new no entry restriction and commence with the advertisement of the associated traffic management order (TMO).
- 2.2 A statutory consultation with Wricklemarsh Road and surrounding roads in the area will take place as part of the Traffic Management Order process.
- 2.3 If there are no objections to the no entry restriction during the TMO advertisement then the existing banned turns will be removed and the enforcement camera would be located.
