

Background

The Royal Borough of Greenwich is committed to providing high quality sustainable transport options for residents and visitors to the Borough. Walking and cycling reduce local air pollution and congestion, as well as improving public health.

Quietways are a London-wide network of safe, cross-borough quiet routes for cyclists, pedestrians and other vulnerable road users. They are funded by Transport for London

Blackheath Gate forms the main southern entrance to Greenwich Park and sits on a key active travel route into and out of Greenwich Town Centre. Unfortunately, the junction has a poor road safety record with 26 collisions in the past 5 years, the vast majority involving eastbound vehicles not giving way to northbound cyclists.

This scheme's objectives are therefore to:

- Improve the safety of the junction for cyclists and pedestrians
- Enhance an important local walking and cycling link
- Improve the public realm
- Deliver a design compatible with London bus services and London marathon

The proposals have been developed with **The Royal Parks** who are supportive of their implementation.

What are the proposed improvements?

- Creation of raised pedestrian crossings on the west and east sides of the junction to slow vehicles and provide safer crossing points. The proposed surfacing will encourage pedestrians towards the western crossing where vehicle flows are lower and one way
- Traffic calming measures on east and west sides of the junction to slow down vehicles approaching
- Removal of vehicular access to Duke Humphrey Road, making it pedestrians and cycles only, to improve safety and improve visibility for vehicles approaching the junction
- Removal of street clutter and signage where possible
- Addition of grassed areas on Duke Humphrey Road to separate pedestrians and cyclists and create a space more in keeping with surroundings
