Please be aware fraudsters are going door to door claiming to be NHS staff conducting coronavirus tests or welfare visits.

NHS staff are **not** going door to door.

Call the police if someone knocks on your door claiming to be conducting coronavirus tests. Do **NOT** open the door or let them in to your house.

Watch out for scam messages: Don't click on the links or attachments in suspicious emails, and never respond to unsolicited messages and calls that ask for your personal or financial details.



- **NEVER** open attachments or links in unsolicited emails
- **NEVER** give out personal information
- **DELETE** spam emails from your mailbox

Scammers want your name, date of birth & current or previous address to commit identity theft. With it they can:

- Open bank accounts
- Obtain credit cards/loans & benefits
- Order goods / mobile phone contracts
- Take over existing accounts
- Obtain a passport & driving license
