MEMBERS' QUESTIONS ON AGENDA ITEM 14: MOTION ON GRAMMAR SCHOOLS

I. Question from Councillor Spencer Drury, to Councillor Miranda Williams, Cabinet Member for Children's Services

What is the number of Greenwich 11 year olds that went to Grammar Schools for each of the last three years? I would prefer Greenwich residents regardless of primary school if possible.

In addition, could she provide similar figures for 16 year olds?

Reply-

I thank Councillor Drury for his question. The number of Royal Borough of Greenwich pupils transferring to a Grammar school at 11 (secondary transfer) in the last three years is below:

Year	Total RBG resident 11 year olds transferring to secondary school	Total RBG resident 11 year olds transferring to Grammar school
2014	2772	245
2015	2895	274
2016	3064	334

We do not readily hold the data on 16 year olds transferring to grammar schools, the school census only provides us with information on Royal Borough of Greenwich schools' sixth form pupils. We have commissioned a report to provide the necessary data, however this will not be available until after 1st November 2016. I will provide you with this information as soon as it is available.
